
METER ON HOUSE INSTALLATION SPECIFICATIONS 100 AND 200 AMP UNDERGROUND SERVICE



- I. All conduit and accessories must meet electrical grade specifications. All wiring and materials must conform to the requirements of all applicable electrical codes. WEC STRONGLY RECOMMENDS THE USE OF A QUALIFIED ELECTRICIAN.
- 2. All service entrance wiring must be complete and all necessary excavation and conduit ready prior to the time of installation of the materials up the pole. No wire shall be trimmed to fit in any lug or breaker. Reducing pins must be used to remedy this situation.
- 3. For trench specifications 3ft in depth is recommended or as per National Electrical Code.
- 4. Before making any changes in your present entrance or installing a new entrance please call the Cooperative office to make arrangements to have the meter location approved by the Cooperative.
- 5. Any meter base 200 amps or larger that is commercial or industrial shall have a manual bypass switch.
- 6. Trimming of wire strands is not allowed. If wire does not fit into lugs or breakers reducing pins must be used.
